



Cooperative Education Internship

The Cooperative Education/Internship Course (COP202) integrates seminar sessions with an approved, faculty-supervised work experience directly related to the student's major program of study. Students must complete a minimum of 120 hours of work and participate in approximately 12-15 seminar sessions.

The Cooperative Education/Internship Course (COP202) is offered on-site as well as online each semester: fall, winter/spring and summer. Students may participate when they (1) have completed at least 27 credits in their program of study, (2) have taken and passed Composition 1, and (3) have a quality point average of 2.0 or higher.

Students should allow at least 4 weeks prior to the beginning of the course to take advantage of job assistance which includes creating a resume, participating in job search activities, and receiving tips on interview techniques.
