| <p>STEP 1:</p> <p>Mandatory Information Session Attendance</p> | <p>Applicants must attend a Mandatory Information during the academic year prior to admission (after August 2023). | <p>STEP 2:</p> <p>NSCC Online Application for Admission</p> | <p>Submit the online application for the year for which you are applying; regardless of whether you are a new or current student (a previously submitted application does not count). Once you submit your application, the remaining required documents (below) may be uploaded to your account.</p> |
| <p>Communications Proficiency</p> | <p>There are many ways to demonstrate this. (See link below.) 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| Official transcripts from all Colleges/Universities previously attended | <p>All official transcripts from previously attended colleges/universities must be submitted directly to NSCC and uploaded by Admissions staff. If you have previously submitted transcripts and have since completed courses or are currently registered for courses, then you need to submit an updated transcript.
