STEP 1:	Applicants must attend a Mandatory Information Session during the academic year prior to admission (after August 2023). Upcoming dates are available by

STEP 2: ATI TEAS	The preferred site for the ATI TEAS exam is North Shore Community College. Online TEAS exams are not accepted at this time. Students must take the ATI TEAS Version 7. Students whose score reports reflect that they have tested more than two times or at another location other than NSCC must also submit an official TEAS transcript from ATI: <a href="https://atitesting.com/ati_store/">https://atitesting.com/ati_store/</a> Additional charges may apply. Exam	Applicants are limited to three attempts within an academic year (September 1-August 31), regardless of the testing site and program to which they are applying.
	Each of the following sections must be taken: Reading; Math; Science and English.
	<b>Minimum required scores:</b> Reading = 65%, Math = 60%, Science = 44%, and English = no minimum score.
	Applicants who have earned a Bachelor of Science degree from an academic institution accredited by a regional or national accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education will have the TEAS requirement waived.
STEP 3:	Submit the online application for the year for which you are applying; regardless

High School Transcript or GED score report	Upload a copy of your high school transcript or GED score report.
