## Academic Planning

When developing your Academic Plan, the following topics should also be considered:

- Time Management.
- Credit Amounts
- Placement Testing.

## Time Management

Before registering for classes carefully consider the following factors that will impact your time:

- Family Obligations
- Travel Time
- Work Schedule
- Time Available for Homework

## Course Credits

#### What is a credit?

The credits for a course identifies how many hours per week that you will be in the classroom for that course.

A 3 credit course = 3 hours in class per week.

#### How much time do you need for college?

#### 2 to 1 Rule

To effectively balance your time, every hour (credit) that you spend in a class will result in you spending 2 hours outside of the class on homework.

#### **Example:**

You register for 6 credits = 6 hours per week in class. Using the 2 to 1 rule you would need to schedule 12 hours per week outside of class for study.

6 hours in class + 12 hours outside = 18 hours per week

## Placement Testing

Placement Testing evaluates your current academic skills in Math, Reading and Writing. Students **MUST** complete Placement Testing prior to Class Registration **unless** you have:

- SAT scores that meet requirements
- High School GPA that requirements
- Transfer Credits from another college accepted by NSCC

## Payment Methods

NSCC's Electronic Billing system is the official means of generating tuition bills to our students. **PAPER BILLS WILL NOT BE MAILED.** Students, and the additional users they authorize, will be notified by e-mail each time a new billing statement becomes available.

#### **How to Pay:**

- Online with Credit Card.
- Online through WebCheck.
- In person with Credit Card or Check.
- Financial Aid package.
- NSCC does not accept cash.

#### Financial Aid package information:

- a) To apply for financial aid, students must complete <u>Free Application for</u> <u>Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u>
- b) You are able to check your Financial Aid Award in your campus account once it has been fully processed.

## Steps After Class Selection

- 2. Waive **Health Insurance** Charge (if necessary)
