
Open Access Online Course – NSCC Arithmetic Preparation



How to Self-Enroll in NSCC Arithmetic Preparation


1. Log into Blackboard Learn and click on the "Courses" tab in your Blackboard Learn "My Home" page.




2. In the "Course Search" area, type the word "arithmetic" and click "Go".




3. You will see a link for the course "ArithmeticPrep" under Course ID. Click on that link.
