ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Associate of Science in Nursing – North Shore Community College to RN to BS Program in Nursing – Saint Anselm College

Saint Anselm College agrees to accept into its Hybrid-online Baccalaureate Program in Nursing, registered nurses who have graduated in good standing with an Associate Degree in Nursing from North Shore Community College with a minimum grade-point average of 3.0 (Exceptions to this GPA requirement can be made by the Director of the Program and the Dean of the College) and a grade of C or higher in all transferred courses and who satisfactorily complete the following requirements for admission:

- Submit application for admission to the Admissions Office at Saint Anselm College
- The \$50 application fee is waived for articulation program applications.
- Submit official high school and college transcripts from Associate of Science Degree in Nursing
- Submit evidence of RN licensure
- Statement of goals for obtaining a BSN degree
- Written summary of experience in nursing
- Interview with Director of the RN-BSN program

A written notification of admission will be mailed to each successful applicant by the Director of the RN to BSN Program. College graduates accepted to Saint Anselm College through this articulation agreement may complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree in as little as 18 months or up to five (5) years.

This Agreement shall commence on April 17, 2016 and shall terminate on April 16, 2019 when it will again be reviewed for renewal. This agreement is subject to catalog and/or program revisions at both institutions, however, this agreement will continue to apply to students who transfer from North Shore Community College within one year of the expiration of this agreement.
