

Clearing Cookies & Cached Images in Your Browser

The easiest way to fix this is to use the following trick:

- 1. Open your Browser
- 2. Go to the login page <u>https://my.northshore.edu</u>
- 3. While on the CAS login page press the control (**CTRL**) key and the **F5** simultaneously on your keyboard. This will force a complete reload of the page and resolve your issue.

Alternatively you can Delete Cookies and Cached Images in your browser by following the steps below.

Note: You do not need to clear your browsing history

Chrome

1. Select the three dots in the upper right corner



- 2. Select Settings
- 3. Select Privacy and Security then select Clear Browsing Data
- 4. Uncheck everything but Cookies and other site data & Cached images and files.

Firefox (using latest version of Firefox Browser)

- 1. Select the Hamburger Menu in the upper right corner
- 2. Select **Options**
- 3. Select Privacy and Security from the left hand menu
- 4. Scroll down the page and locate the **Cookies and Site data** section. Select **Clear Data** the screen below will display. Check off the two options available and select **Clear**
