**BASICS**

- You will be enrolled in one (1) free-of-charge college course. **Students will be responsible for textbooks, transportation and instructional materials.**
- All official communication from NSCC will be sent to your NSCC email address - you will need to check your college email every day.
- Your college ID will give you access to our Library, Tutoring Services, Student Life Activities, Advising Office, Accessibility Services and all other college resources.

**ACADEMICS**

- You are expected to follow your instructor's syllabus for the course, adhere to the instructor's and college's code of conduct, come prepared for class and contribute positively to the classroom environment.
- You will need to spend time outside of class to prepare and complete assignments. NOTE: You will spend at least 2 additional hours for every hour spent in class (Example: 3 hours of class + 6 hours of time outside of class = 9 hours per week in study).
- You are expected to attend each class and to email your instructor well in advance (typically 24 hours before) if you need to be absent.
- Any missed classes may result in penalties, please refer to the attendance policy in your class syllabus.

**IMPORTANT DATES & POLICIES**

- The official date for dropping a spring course without penalty – with **no record on your official college transcript** – is **February 2, 2020**.
- The last day to withdraw from your course with a grade of "W" is **April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020**.
- **Withdrawing from a class after the April 11<sup>th</sup> deadline will have a negative impact on your official college transcript and may impact future financial aid eligibility.**
- If you never attend or stop attending a class, this does not equal a withdrawal from the course. If you want to withdraw from your class, please speak with your instructor first, then email us at [earlycollege@northshore.edu](mailto:earlycollege@northshore.edu).
