- Passing grade in at least 3 credits of coursework or a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Plan to continue education at NSCC in Fall 2019

The English as a Second Language Scholarship was established in 2000 for NSCC students taking ESL courses at NSCC. ESL programming began in 1982 at NSCC to assist English Language Learners who want to earn a college degree.
