The Jeffrey Thompson Memorial Scholarship was established to provide financial assistance for tuition, fees and certain assistive technologies for students at North Shore Community College (NSCC) who have a permanent physical or other disability.

Amount of Award: In-state tuition and fees for up to 12 credits for fall, spring or summer semesters plus a one-time additional amount of up to \$1,000 to be used for assistive technology, a laptop, or books. This scholarship is renewable for subsequent semesters, provided the student maintains the eligibility requirements and a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher. Two awards are available: one award for an incoming NSCC student (high school cumulative GPA of 3.0), and one award for a current NSCC student (minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher).

Eligibility: Applicants must have documented a permanent disability with the NSCC Accessibility Services office; enrolled in a NSCC degree or certificate program; and have financial need.

Note: Preference will be given to students with permanent physical disabilities. Other students with permanent disabilities will also be considered.
