

AGREEMENT FOR ARTICULATION BETWEEN ENDICOTT COLLEGE 7/14/14
AND NORTH SHORE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Endicott College (located in Beverly, Massachusetts) and North Shore Community College (located in Danvers, Massachusetts) hereby enter into an agreement to facilitate the transfer of students completing the Associate of Science Degree with a major in Nursing at North Shore Community College into the bachelor's of science degree with a major in Nursing at Endicott College.

This agreement applies to graduates of North Shore Community College who have an Associate of Science in Nursing and who have been admitted to the Endicott College Bachelor of Science degree program with a major in nursing. After completion of the student's program of study and the earning of an unrestricted license, the student may apply to Endicott College and if accepted, the following courses and credits will be applied to their program of study at Endicott. Courses must carry grades of C or better.

General Electives:

In order to fulfill the Endicott College general education requirements, students must complete one course (three credits) from each of the eight thematic categories listed below. In addition, students must complete four general electives outside of their major and concentration requirements. These four electives, two of which must be above the 100 level, may be taken from the thematic categories or from other areas of the College wide curriculum. The general electives as well as the courses associated with the thematic categories may be used to fulfill minor requirements. Please note: NSCC courses SOC106, CMP104-150 and Nursing Directed Elective may be used to meet these general education requirements.

The program of study is described in Addendum A. General Education electives are listed in Addendum B.

Non-credit nor remedial courses determined to be below college credit will not be accepted for transfer.

After successful completion of a minimum of 126 credits, including all required courses, and having been cleared for graduation by Endicott's Registrar, the RN students will be eligible for the Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing.

This agreement is expected to continue indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with one year's notice.
